Participants who attend this program will:

- experience and discuss hands-on physical science activities involving magnetism, electricity, electrical safety, forces and motion, gravity, temperature, and kitchen science;
- discuss science instruction strategies that research indicates are best suited to early learners;
- increase confidence in leading science learning activities;
- and receive instructional kits that contain activities presented during the workshop, a variety of resource books, and materials needed to conduct the experiences back in the classroom.
